Club fees: New approach for the coming season

Please take note that players and parents will be contacted by the team representatives / coaches personally in regard to outstanding fees. Gerhard de Vos is currently sending out club fee statements to members and parents reminding them of outstanding amounts.

Please contact **Gerhard de Vos** directly in this regard. If you are leaving the club, please just send us an email to Jacques van Wyk, in order to amend the already compiled budget and for administrative purposes.

The following will apply during the 2018/2019 season:

- Strictly, no member will be released from the club if he or she is not a paid-up member. This is normal procedure throughout clubs as instructed by the NCU, and is also written into the Bye Laws of the NCU, to which the club must adhere to.
- A player will also not be released if there are any outstanding disciplinary matters against him or herself.
- The pay and play structure of the Club will proceed.
- The MCC to introduce fewer teams into the NCU league system as the lower jnr leagues' playing conditions are very poor and playing opportunities far less.

The following league structure would be introduced during the 2018/2019 cricket season:

Junior teams

- U9 Gold
- U9 Platinum
- U11 Gold
- U11 Gold
- U13 Silver



- U13 Gold
- U15 Platinum

Please Note that each team will consist of only 15 players for the season.

Senior teams

- Promotion league – 1st Team
- President league – 2nd Team
- 3rd team in the 4th league
- 4th team in the 4th league

If player's numbers exceeds the threshold numbers, more teams will be introduced to accommodate players, if possible (Dependent on the availability of further teams at the NCU, coaches and fields.) Please note that this not a new concept. It was only our club who did not enforce the pay-play system in the past. This system already proven highly effective. It was implemented during the previous season in the Club Structure with great success.

Players and parents are afforded ambit opportunity to pay club fees before the commencing of the new cricket season, which are **3rd September 2018. I must therefore reiterate that no member will be allowed to attend practice sessions or to play if his/her club fees are not paid and no arrangements were made with Jacques van Wyk and Gerhard de Vos.**

Advantages of the system:

- Less administration during the cricket season
- Fair treatment of paid-up versus not paid-up members
- Maintenance planning to facilities
- Obtaining of more skilled coaches and fair salaries
- More controlled structures (existing members/new members, etc)
- Honorarium payments to some of the Board members, etc which ultimately has to be done to make up for on-going expenses made on behalf of our club.
- More effective financial planning and compiling of budget and other financial statements.
- All members will pay club fees **once-off** or on a **pro rata-basis**, depending on when they become a member of the club.

Club fees for the season are as follows:

- Senior club fees: From ages 16 years and older is **R 1110-00** for the season. Payable before the 3rd of September 2018 for the season.
- Junior club fees: From ages 6 to 15 years is **R1025-00** for the season. Payable before the 3rd of September 2018 for the season.

The MCC is a community based club, which is primarily dependant on club fees. Our club fees are fair in comparison with other senior clubs. The fee paid to the club is directly going back to our members and parents in some or other way, by paying coaches, buying equipment, paying for maintenance and repair to facilities, etc..

Trials

We will start with the senior and junior player trials in August. There are junior teams still to play trail games. This will ensure that players are placed correctly and can play in a team that suits his/her skills. The delegated coaches will be assisted by our senior team members with the necessary skills and extensive cricketing background.

We plea to our members and parents to please take this information as serious. We will be having a meeting with our senior members to again communicate with them the seriousness of what and why it is expecting from them.

Junior club off-season games

Currently clubs are negotiating junior games during the off-season. Games are being played on Saturdays. Game fixtures will be communicated with our parents.

We are also planning an August Cricket Tournament for the Junior Players. More information will follow. But this is subject to the availability of fields, etc..

Use of school cricket facilities

Parents and members please note that the club is limited in the use of school cricket facilities. On times prescribed during games and practice times are we allowed to make use of the facilities. Please adhere to this plea. Right off admission is therefore reserved only to in-season training. No player are allowed to use any of the facilities during the off season. Players and or visitors are also not allowed to wonder around on the school grounds, as this triggers alarms and cause management problems.

Communication

During the season, the only form of communication will be via emails and whatsapp. Please do not remove yourself from the whatsapp groups, read your email, and stay connected to the club and its activities. Please revert from posting any advertisements or any personal messages, not being MCC cricket related. If there is anything that any of you want to discuss with management, please do not do so on the groups, but send a personal message to the chairman or make direct contact with him by phone.
